Dr. Wilton T. Anderson, Sr.

November 29, 1916–November 15, 2012
Stillwater



Wilton Thomas Anderson was born in Richland, Texas on November 29, 1916, to Ruth Skipper and William Nix Anderson. He died peacefully on November 15, 2012 in Oklahoma City, just two weeks short of his 96th birthday.

His parents moved to Cherokee, Okla. in 1921, where Wilton attended public schools from grades 1 through 12. He graduated from Cherokee High School in 1933.

Wilton began his college experience in 1933 at Northwestern Oklahoma State University, in Alva, Okla. and in 1938 he earned a bachelor's degree in economics and education. He then pursued a Master's in Commercial Education and graduated from the University of Oklahoma in 1942. Wilton later completed his Doctorate in Education from the University of Colorado in 1953.

Known throughout his illustrious teaching career as an “Accounting Evangelist,” Dr. Anderson influenced the lives and careers of thousands of students, faculty members whom he recruited, and fellow accounting educators. Wilton taught at several colleges and universities including: Northern Oklahoma College, Tonkawa, 1940-46; Bowling Green (Ken.) College of Commerce in 1946-47; University of Colorado, Boulder, 1947-57; Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, 1960-1982, where he also served as the Accounting Department Chair; and the University of Hawaii, Honolulu, 1982-83. From 1957 through 1960, Wilton was Director of Education of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants in New York, where he supervised the preparation and grading of the Uniform CPA Examination used in all 50 states.

In addition to his teaching assignments, Anderson's professional memberships included the Oklahoma Education Association, American Accounting Association, and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The American Accounting Association elected Dr. Anderson as national vice-president and later as president of that organization. He was a founder and organizer of the Federation of Schools of Accountancy, and organizer of the Oklahoma Accounting Educators Association.

Anderson received significant awards throughout his life-long career. Anderson was named Outstanding Teacher, OSU College of Business Administration: 1963, 1969 and 1970; Outstanding Teacher, Oklahoma State University, 1970. He was the first recipient of the American Accounting Association's Outstanding Accounting Educator Award in 1973. In 1974, he was named as an Outstanding Alumnus of Northwestern Oklahoma State University, and in 1978, he was inducted into the Oklahoma Accounting Hall of Fame. In October 1999, he was named to the Oklahoma Higher Education Hall of Fame. Every year since 1979, the OSU School of Accounting in the Spears School of Business has honored outstanding graduates as Distinguished Alumni at the Wilton T. Anderson Hall of Fame Awards Banquet. This event is dedicated to Dr. Wilton Anderson, the “founding father of the OSU School of Accounting.” It is the highest honor the School of Accounting can bestow on an alumnus.

Marc A Delametter graduated from Oklahoma State University in May 1983 with a Bachelor of Science Business Administration, Accounting Major degree. He became a Certified Public Accountant in Oklahoma in 1986.

Marc started his professional career in July 1983 as a staff accountant for Price Waterhouse in Tulsa, Oklahoma. In June 1986 Marc began a new career with QuikTrip Corporation as a General Corporate Accountant. Over the next 28 years Marc worked his way through various iterations of positions at QuikTrip including Corporate Tax manager, General Accounting Manager, Assistant Controller, Controller and ultimately Vice President Accounting/Controller. When Marc retired in May 2014 QuikTrip had grown to be one of the largest privately held corporation in the United States, with revenues greater than \$14 billion and (more importantly) had achieved the status of “Best Companies to Work For” in the United States by Fortune Magazine many years over.

The School of Accounting Collaborative for Academic Excellence (ACE)

The School of Accounting Collaborative for Academic Excellence (ACE) is primarily funded through generous contributions from ConcoPhillips, Phillips 66, and EY and contributions to various scholarships and the general scholarship fund. During the spring, summer, and fall of 2016, the ACE program provided walk-in tutoring sessions and targeted group sessions to students enrolled in all undergraduate School of Accounting courses. Over the course of the year, assistance was provided in over 3,000 individual and group tutoring sessions. In addition to help on the Stillwater campus, students may also seek assistance on the Tulsa campus or via Skype. ACE also continued a series of small group meetings between students, faculty, and professionals, hosting a number of professionals over the course of the year. These sessions give students the opportunity to interact with a diverse group of experienced individuals, gaining insight and a connection that might not otherwise be readily attainable.
