

What are the admission requirements?

Admissions are decided on a holistic approach with successful candidates meeting the following criteria preferences:

- Undergraduate degree
- Overall GPA 3.0
- ACCT upper division* GPA 3.25
- GMAT 550

GMAT Waiver applicable if the applicant meets:

- ACCT upper Division Prerequisite Courses
- Overall GPA 3.5

What are the application requirements?

- Completed Application
- Letter of Recommendation
- Personal Statement
- Resume

How long does it take to get through the graduate program?

- The program is 33-34 hours, depending on the chosen concentration
- The program coursework begins in the summer and is completed the following spring or summer depending on the chosen concentration.

When should I apply?

- All program candidates will begin coursework in Summer
- Priority application deadline is 1/17/20
- Final application deadline is 4/1/20
