Melvin Gilliam is the son a retired TPS Teacher as well as a product of the TPS Magnet School Program. He was the number 1 recruit in Oklahoma in football and basketball his senior year. Melvin was named to numerous All American list such as McDonald's All American Team in basketball and The Parade All American Team in football just to name a few. He also was named to the All State, All District, All City and All Conference teams. Mr. Gilliam was the Player of the Year in football his senior year. Melvin also was named to the Academic All American team as well. He received scholarship offers from every Division 1 college in the country.

Mr. Gilliam received a bachelor's degree in business from Oklahoma State University where he played football and basketball. He was the first freshman in OSU History to start in 2-sports as a freshman. After graduating from OSU he played professional football for the Philadelphia Eagles as well as the San Antonio Riders of the Professional World League, now called the World League Europe.

Mr. Gilliam is currently a Business Banker with SpiritBank located in Downtown Tulsa at the Corporate Office. His responsibilities include a broad range of all banking services from opening new Consumer and Commercial accounts to Treasury Management/ Cash Management services. He also makes calls on new and existing potential Consumer, Commercial and Mortgage loans clients. He also represents SpiritBank in various community activities.
