DAY IN THE LIFE

PUBLIC ACCOUNTING (EXTERNAL AUDIT)

- Gather evidence/information through communications with the client, observations, and tests
- Provides guidance on the financial statements and internal controls
- Work at client site more often than working in the office

PUBLIC ACCOUNTING (TAX)

- Collect information from client and organize into different databases (to make the information useful)
- Create state/federal extension and tax forms, client communications, K-1's
- Learn about client industry through client on-site and virtual meetings
- Update control lists, payment schedules
- Work primarily in the office, rather than the client sit

FORENSIC ACCOUNTING

- Investigate financial crimes (usually involving property fraud)
- Testify in court (as an expert in the field)

INDUSTRY ACCOUNTING

- Create financial reports and budgets from available financial information
- Determine and maintain records of profit/loss, assets, liabilities (including tax liabilities), etc
- Keep a record of all financial information within the company (general ledger)
- Determine tax liability

INTERNAL AUDITOR

- Provide independent/objective opinions on the company's internal controls
- Look at operations, compliance, controls, and safeguards
- Work with the external auditor
