#### **ELECTIVES: 7 HOURS**

### Other Requirements:

- A minimum of 50 percent of the business hours required for a degree must be in residence at OSU.
- Forty-five hours of upper division courses and a minimum of 60 hours must be completed at a 4-year institution.
- A minimum of 15 of the last 30 hours must be in residence at OSU.
