AMOUNT: \$1,000

DURATION: Up to 2 academic years

TYPE OF AWARD: Cash scholarship. Pays in fall & spring terms only

NUMBER AWARDED: Up to 15 new awards each year; renewable awards will vary

AWARDED TO: Sophomore Students (new)

FINANCIAL NEED REQUIRED? No

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at Oklahoma State University, classified as a rising sophomore level student at the time of the application. Student must be pursuing a degree in one of the following majors: **accounting, computer science, engineering (any discipline) and/or geoscience**. Recipients must also demonstrate optimism, teamwork, creativity, resourcefulness and the ability to deal with others in an open and ethical manner and will be selected based upon their leadership potential, academic and career interests as determined by the selection committee.

RENEWAL CRITERIA: Recipients will receive the award for a two-year period provided he/she maintains full-time enrollment status in one of the following majors: accounting, computer science, engineering (any discipline) and/or geoscience, maintains a grade point average of at least 3.0, completes the assigned service project and continues to be involved in campus leadership activities.
